During this time of national emergency, I want to let our community know what the Vinton County Board of Developmental Disabilities is doing in response to the COVID-19 pandemic.

Vinton DD staff will continue to provide services and support to individuals, families and our provider network using remote work capabilities. We have closed our building to the public, and by the end of business on Monday, March 23 all our staff will be working remotely. Because of the nature of our work, we have designated our staff members as essential staff, meaning that they will be available to respond to emergency situations and conduct business that cannot be done remotely.

We have limited face-to-face contact by our staff with the public to emergency situations only. I am confident in the ability of the staff of Vinton DD to continue to assure that the people we support continue to receive quality services.

The days before us will bring uncertainty, and plans we have in place now may very well change with changing conditions. One thing that will not change, however, is our commitment to support Vinton County individuals and their families to the best of our ability.
