Early Intervention (EI) provides coordinated early intervention services to parents of eligible children under the age of three with developmental delays or disabilities.

Madison Radabaugh is the Developmental Specialist for Vinton County. Madison comes with a wealth of knowledge and experience with young children and loves working with the families of Vinton County.



Jakelyn Brown is the Early Intervention Service Coordinator for Vinton County. Jakelyn coordinates services for the children and families. Jakelyn is able to create a support system for Vinton County families that empowers and promotes developmental growth for their children.
